

Paper Flowers

Create colorful flowers to decorate your home for Earth Day. These flowers will last much longer than real flowers, and they are eco-friendly since they are made from newspaper or magazine pages.

What you will need:

- Magazine pages or newspaper (colorful glossy magazines work well)
- Pencil or pen
- Scissors
- Double sided tape
- Wooden skewers



What to do:

- Cut out a circle from a newspaper or magazine page.
- Draw a spiral shape on it.
- Cut the spiral starting from the edges of the circle.
- Roll your cut out spiral until you reach the center.
- Gently release to reveal your flower.
- Wrap a piece of double sided tape onto the bottom of the flower and attach it to the top of the wooden skewer.
